**Jill DiSanti** is currently entering her 11th year of coaching overall, her 9th overall year at Monmouth University and her 2nd as the Associate Head Coach. While at Monmouth she has developed 21 NEC honorees, 15 MAAC, 12 Mid-

Atlantic All-Americans, 1 players of the year and 2 National All-American MAAC players of the year, 3 defensive players of the year and 2 attacking players of the year. Prior to joining the Hawks in March of 2007. Prior to joining the Hawks in March of 2007 DiSanti served as the assistant a Quinnipiac University for three seasons. She is also the Co-Owner of the Surf & Sand FHC. A 2005 graduate of Quinnipiac University, DiSanti helped lead the Bobcats to two Northeast Conference tournament titles (2001, 2003), two NCAA tournament appearances (2001, 2003) and the 2002 NEC regular season title. The first team in conference history to finish the regular season with a perfect mark. In addition DiSanti, was a two time NFCA Mid-East Region All-American (2003, 2004) as well as a three-time All-Northeast Selection (2002, 2003, 2004). She was also named the (2004) Most Valuable Player and served as the teams Captain in 2004. **Maggie Long** joined the Rutgers Athletic Development team in March 2012. As Development Assistant, Maggie will spearhead the annual giving campaign, special events coordination, Rutgers Scholarship Program, donor stewardship and fan relations. Prior to her arrival at

Rutgers University, Long spent five seasons as the assistant coach for the Monmouth field hockey program after completing a stellar playing career at the College of William and Mary. Maggie helped guide the Hawks to back-to-back-to back Northeast Conference Championships game appearances.
